1st Plant Mrs L. Spring Wren at Plantocracy: A pretty feminine bitch with a narrow front with good lay of shoulder, deep chest and tuck up to give a nice outline and held her top line well. Moved with good reach and drive for one so young. Promising young bitch BEST PUPPY IN SHOW

2nd Entwistle Ms H. Holtaire Runa: Another feminine bitch. nice shaped head and good lay of shoulder with straight well marked legs set underneath. Nice hind quarters good bend of stifle with tight feet moved well.

BEGINNERS

1st Oboyle Mrs S. Rattustrap Happy To Be Here at Ruffagga: 20 month old bitch has a good wedge head with dark eye, good length of neck tapering nicely to her shoulders with a deep chest. Good Markings Tight feet with pencilling. Moved better going away, just couldn't seem to get into her stride today

POST GRADUATE

1st Lomas Ms C. Hurrockheath Miss Emmeline: Good wedge shaped head with dark almond eye. Straight front with well muscled shoulders gleaming black coat with rich mahogany tan. Good angulation which produced a flowing movement
